

# **PROPOSAL**



## **Proposal**

After much research and discussion, PASS has designed a solution that we think is the best solution for our students.

### **PPCD**

Place them in a school near the current CCISD campus of Hall Elementary. The campuses to consider are Ross, Bauerschlag or Gilmore Elementary. Since there is not a regular education PPCD program, the 3-5 year olds are not mainstreaming in other areas at the campus, so transitioning to another elementary would not be interrupting long term-relationships at this point.

### **K - 5<sup>th</sup>**

Continue to stay at Hall Elementary where the current 2<sup>nd</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> graders are located as well as the new GBCHI offices.

### **6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>**

Continue to stay at Creekside Intermediate where the current 6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> graders are located.

### **9<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>**

To start the program with the new 9<sup>th</sup> graders coming out of Creekside Intermediate in the Fall 2007 and leaving the current Alvin students to graduate in the school that they have started. Then each following year a new 9<sup>th</sup> grade class would move in. This plan would take 4 years, 2007-2011, to get a full GBCHI onsite high school campus at Clear Springs High School. As the student numbers decrease at Alvin High School due to graduation, the teachers can move over to Clear Springs High School.
